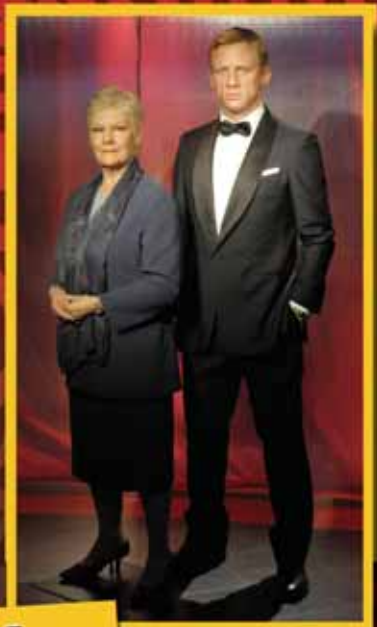
MADAME TUSSAUDS
